**Sarp Yacht signs deal with Northrop & Johnson for its SARP 46M superyacht**

Turkish superyacht-builder Sarp Yacht has signed an exclusive brokerage deal with Northrop & Johnson in the US for its SARP 46M superyacht. The yacht has a selling price of €22.5m.

Designed and built according to ABS rules, the new yacht is nearing completion and is due to make its global debut at the Monaco Yacht Show in September.

Winner of a 2015 International Yacht & Aviation Award in the 'yacht concept over 40m' category, the SARP 46 has a steel hull and composite superstructure. Exterior design is from Turkish company Taka Yacht Design, with an interior from Adam Lay Studio in the UK.

The SARP 46 is the company's first-ever superyacht, having previously focused on refit work at its yard in Turkey's Antalya Free Zone.

Sarp Yacht is jointly owned by the Eti Group, one of Turkey's most recognised food brands, and Turkish logistics firm Sarp Havacılık Lojistik Turizm Sanayi Ticaret A.S.
